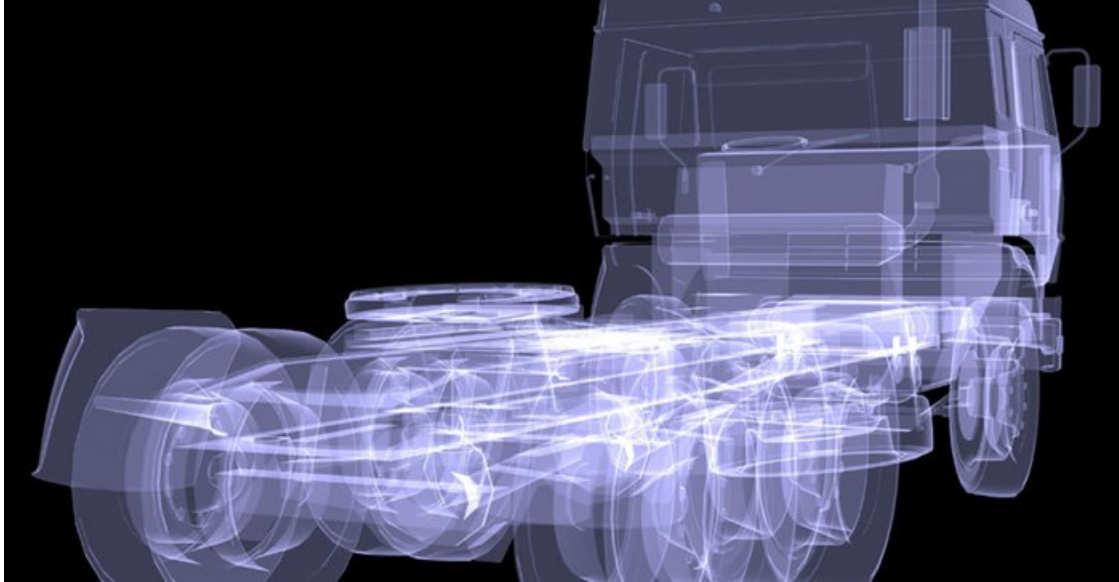


TruckX industry survey: the best of the best selected
