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JHP Gourmet Guide awarded best in the world by Gourmand World Cookbook Awards

The Gourmand World Cookbook Awards has awarded the 2018 JHP Gourmet Guide *Best in the World*. Founded by Edouard Cointreau in 1995, the awards honour the best international food and wine books each year.

There are no restaurant nor hotel advertisements – it is neutral and unbiased, with restaurants initially judged anonymously.

Only 21 restaurants and their chefs are awarded plates.

The plating rating

- · One plate is awarded for excellent cuisine
- Two plates are awarded for exceptional dining that demands a detour
- Three plates are awarded for world-class destination dining worthy of a flight

The Swiss Culinary Innovation Award 2018, presented by Swiss International Air Lines, was won by female chef Chantel Dartnall – this

was an assurance that the JHP Gourmet Guide team knows what it takes to evaluate the intricacies of culinary expertise. With the guide being a conduit, this year will see South African chefs from plated restaurants competing in Taittinger's le Culinaire Prix, the world's oldest and most prestigious chef competition.
