

AFI Joburg Fashion Week to showcase #AfroAsia fashion flair

The 2018 African Fashion International (AFI) Joburg Fashion Week will be held in Melrose Arch, Johannesburg from 4-7 October 2018. In the theme #AfroAsia, AFI Joburg Fashion Week 2018 is set to showcase the best of African fashion with a sprinkle of Asian flavour.



The lineup includes fashion design stars from across the continent: Nigeria's Deola Sagoe and Clan, Haute Baso from Rwanda, and Kahindo from the DRC.
