NEW YORK, US: New York Festivals <u>International Radio Programs & Promos Awards</u> will recognise the World's Best Radio Programs at the 2013 awards ceremony taking place on 17 June at Manhattan Penthouse in New York City.



Established in 1982, the competition honours the most innovative work in radio broadcasting with entries from radio stations, networks, and independent producers from around the globe.
