

## 'Iron Duke' Khoza: multitasking or conflict of interest?

Having been nominated recently to the position of President of the South African Sports Confederation and Olympic Committee (Sascoc), Irvin Khoza's decision to seek another term - unopposed - as PSL chairman is seen by many as a mistake, *KickOff.com* says.



Revelations by Sascoc that Khoza will be the sole challenger to Gideon Sam for the position of president at Sascoc's December elections have raised questions, as Khoza already holds multiple responsibilities as PSL chairman, Orlando Pirates chairman and Safa vice president.
