

Stephen Haw appointed editor of The Times

Times Media has announced that Stephen Haw has been appointed editor of The Times, with effect from 1 May. Haw is currently the editor of the Sunday Times Express edition.



Under Haw's leadership, the Express edition has grown overall sales of the Sunday Times by more than 30% in the areas in which it is available.

Prior to his role as editor of the Express edition, Haw was the editorial product development director for Times Media. In this capacity, he led the team that conceived and designed The Times. Haw was also the founding editor of the Sunday Times Lifestyle section, which won several industry awards under his stewardship.

Haw says of his appointment, "This is a wonderful opportunity to build on the success that has been achieved by my predecessors at The Times, Ray Hartley and Phylicia Oppelt. I feel very privileged to be building on their legacy."

Dominic Mahlangu, deputy editor of The Times, will serve as acting editor until May.
