

Koome Mwambia to exit Ogilvy Kenya

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The Board of Ogilvy Kenya has announced that it has accepted Koome Mwambia's decision to take an early exit as CEO and director of the company. In a statement issued by the board's chairman, Bharat Thakrar, the board stated that the decision had been arrived at mutually, after various discussions between the parties.
