

SABC refuses to apologise to M&G

NEWSWATCH: The SABC is refusing to apologise on air to the *Mail & Guardian* over the <u>Robert Gumede</u> fiasco, and intends to appeal to ICASA now, after the BCCSA last week rejected its appeal, reports Eyewitness News, and the Nelson Mandela Foundation is holding a meeting tomorrow between government ministers and officials, MPs and civil society groups to "try to resolve the impasse over the [Secrecy Bill]", reports IOL.
