

# South African MBA Programmes in the Top 200 in the World

South African MBA programmes ranks among the Top 200 in the world. This is according to the Eduniversal 2013/2014 global ranking of Executive MBA degrees, a resource used by students around the world to compare top business schools.

Rankings for the Eduniversal Masters Ranking 2013/2014 are based primarily on a survey of recent graduates, taking also into consideration input from a professional HR firm on the employability of graduates as well as a School's overall Eduniversal ranking.
