

Call to enter Sing 'it for the chance to win R50 000

How the competition works

- All approved entries will be published on LitNet
- Each band/artist will choose their favourite lyric from the pool of submissions, and compose and record a song from it. Five of these chosen lyrics will win R5000 cash
- All six songs will be made available for the public to download via Facebook
- The song with the most votes becomes the overall winner and the lyric writer wins R50000
- The winning song will also be produced into a music video and the winner will have the opportunity of featuring in it.
