

HIV/AIDS: Spanish researchers report encouraging results in search for therapeutic HIV vaccine

MADRID, SPAIN: According to a report in *BDLive*, Spanish researchers claim that they have developed a therapeutic vaccine that can temporarily brake the growth of HIV in infected patients.



The vaccine, according to the *BD Live* report, "is based on immune cells exposed to HIV that had been inactivated with heat". The researchers are reported as saying that the new vaccine was tested on a group of 36 people carrying the virus and "the results were the best yet recorded for such a treatment".
