"Following on the success of last year's Youth Show for beginners at the first Cape Dairy Experience, we decided to give more youngsters an opportunity to lead a cow or goat around the show ring," says Milford. "One of the highlights will undoubtedly be the Cape Holstein Youth Show Championships that will be presented in honour of the 100 year anniversary of the Holstein Breed Society. Experienced learners, dressed to the nines, will prepare and show their animals in three age categories."
