

Standard Bank sponsors new Wine Writer of the Year competition

The recently launched 2013 Du Toitskloof Wines' Wine Writer of the Year competition has announced the co-sponsorship of Standard Bank. The competition, which aims to reward in-depth writing on challenges facing the wine industry, is a first for South Africa in that all the participants have to submit an article on the same topic.

Marius Louw, MD of Du Toitskloof Wines, said the bank's involvement would lend further stature to the competition. We have structured the competition to provide wine writers with the opportunity to submit thoroughly researched articles based on a different topic every year. The competition is open to published wine writers who have to submit an in-depth article on the topic "The consequences of climate change for the South African wine industry," by 27 September 2013.
