Running on innovation

The production doesn't just talk about innovation; it runs on it: half the show is powered by renewable energy. "In essence designed to be a sustainability consciousness shifter," says Rabinowitz. "We'd like to create an experience that leaves people feeling good, but also deliver a strong message to keep them thinking once they leave. Predictably what they'll be thinking once they leave is 'How can I drive off without paying the car guard?' but maybe after that they might wonder about how to funnel grey water into the sprinkler system."

Power Struggle is the hottest (solar powered) ticket in town, whether you're an eco-warrior or just an eco-worrier. Or, like most of us, you don't have a clue what's going on, and just want to know that the kids are going to be all right.
