

White Mountain 2010 line-up announced

The White Mountain Festival will be held over the Heritage Day long weekend, 23 to 26 September, 2010, and will cater to tastes as diverse as acoustic rock to blues, folk, world music, bluegrass and maskandi.



Included on the bill for this four-day festival held at White Mountain Lodge near Giant's Castle are Just Jinjer's Ard Matthews, Vusi Mahlasela, acoustic guitarists Tony Cox and Nibs van der Spuy, as well as former Tree 63 frontman, John Ellis.

Other acts are Cape Town's Jack Mantis Band, the Zulu traditional musician Phuzekhemisi, plus Shannon Hope, Margaret's Daughter, Barry Thomson, Machineri, Meri Kenaz, Joshua Grierson, Shomon, Jaspar Lepak, Shannon Kenny and Alan Judd, Redhand Blues Band, The Kickstands and Tresor.

Family-friendly atmosphere

Coinciding with the start of the school holidays, the festival is known for its relaxed, family-friendly atmosphere and idyllic setting in the foothills of the Giant's Castle Nature Reserve - just 34km from Estcourt on tarred roads and 200km from Durban.
