

Chabane to attend African Editors Forum

Minister in The Presidency for Performance Monitoring, Evaluation and Administration, Collins Chabane, is to participate in a debate on the image of the African continent at the African Editors Forum Biannual General Meeting.

The event, expected to be attended by editors and media leaders across the continent as well as government leaders, is scheduled to take place in Kigali, Rwanda from the 27 to 29 November 2012.
