

Telkom: Up to 1,000 managers face axe

Telkom's chief executive Sipho Maseko has moved to calm a storm over his comments last week that up to 1,000 managers face the axe at the company, although he confirmed that its staff numbers would be reduced in wide-ranging efforts to cut costs.
