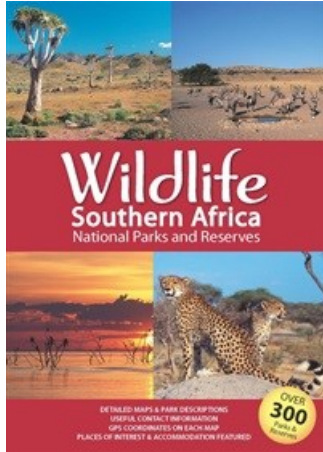


# Atlas of over 300 parks and reserves
