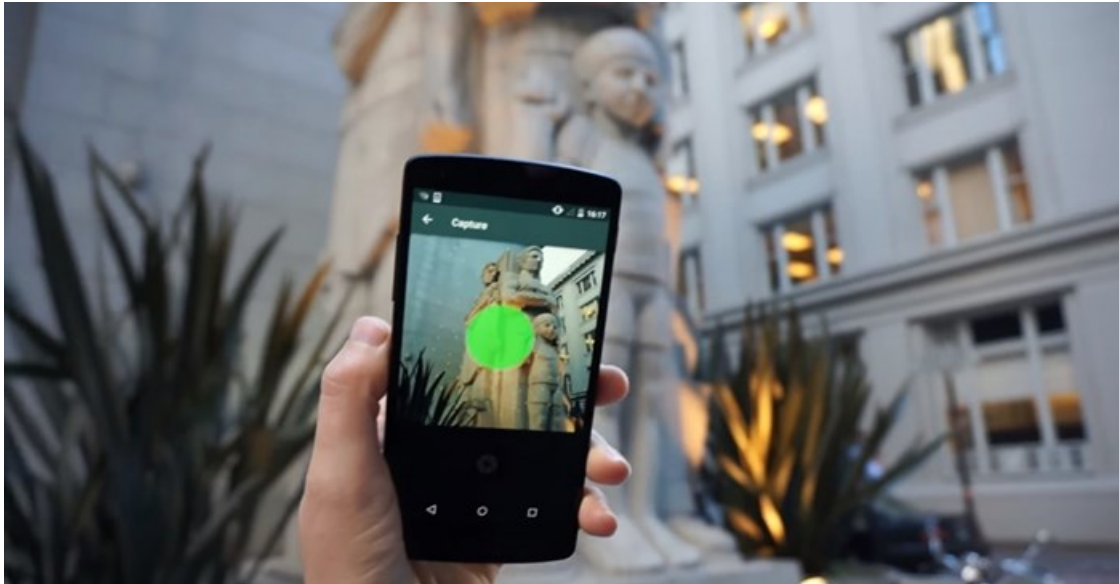


# Snapchat acquires 3D photo app Seene, expect 3D selfies
