

## Africa gets its own domain name - finally - 20 Feb 2017

After years of wrangling through the courts, the .Africa domain name will finally be available to brands and individuals from mid-2017. This follows the resolution of a court case in the United States. ICANN awarded the .Africa domain to South Africa's ZA Central Registry in 2014 and a US court has just upheld that decision after challenges.

But we are here now and it is a hugely positive step, so look out for a flurry of landgrabs for the .Africa domain this year.
