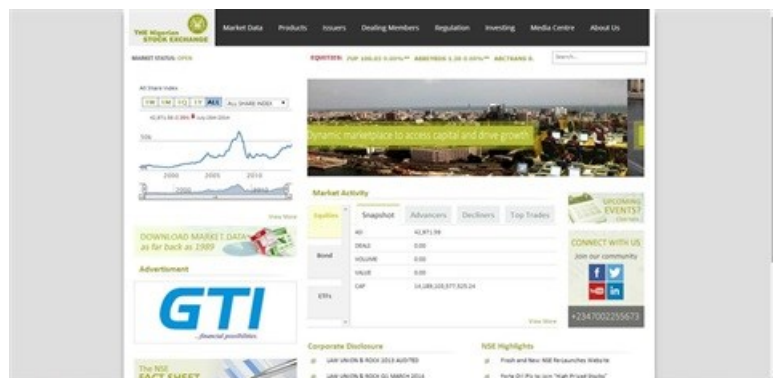


NSE redesigns, relaunches website
