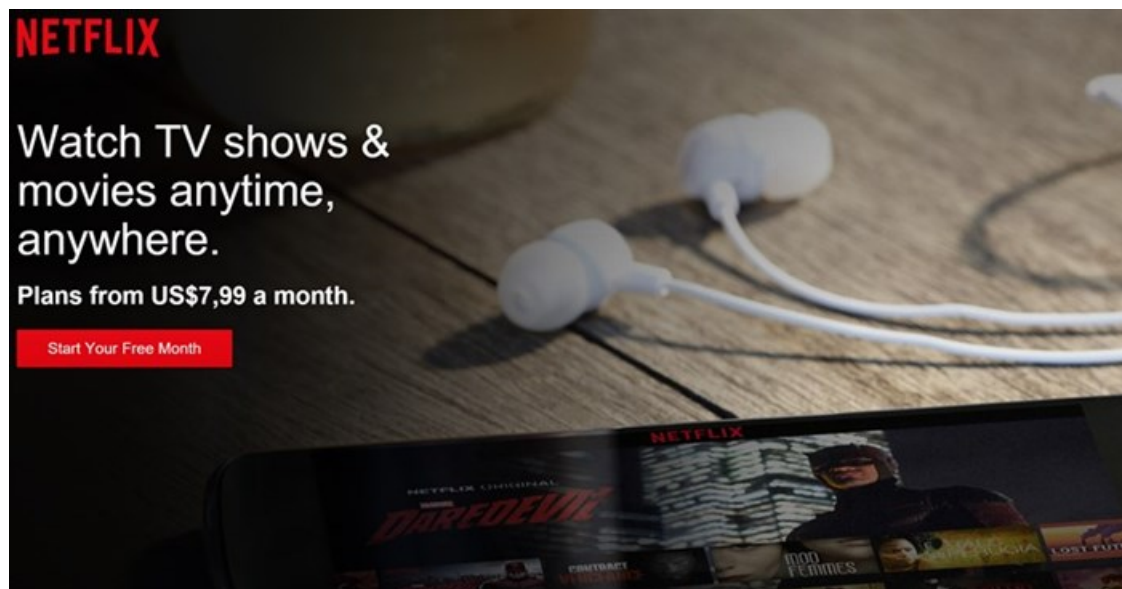


Netflix to be 'exclusive US pay TV home' for Disney, Marvel and more
