

Cape Town dam levels above 60%

For the first time since 2016, dam levels in the City of Cape Town have passed the 60% mark.

For the past week, dam levels improved slightly by 1.3% to 60.1% of storage capacity, and the average water consumption rose from 519-million to 527-million litres per day.

The City of Cape Town said it is encouraged by this milestone. It thanked water users for continuing to use as little water a possible.

"This remains a priority effort to ensure that we build a buffer against the summer months ahead," the city said on Monday 20 August.
