The report, laid bare in an <u>article by the Thomson Reuters Foundation</u>, asserts that "helping women start their own businesses could immediately increase global economic output by as much as \$5tn, about the size of Japan's economy".

Already, women control more than \$20tn in spending and make upwards of 80% of household purchasing decisions worldwide. Investing in women entrepreneurs unlocks new market opportunities – and makes sensible economics: a gender-balanced entrepreneurial ecosystem could raise global GDP by 3-6%, boosting the global economy by \$2.5-\$5tn, reckons the Boston Consulting Group.
