

#### **III** Do you do charity work and, if you do, what do you do?

My One Man Show is a charity-driven show – which is held annually on Christmas day in my community. The event went from attracting 800 people in 2006 to over 15,000 attending the festival in 2019. Every year, we hire buses to accommodate 1,500 kids who receive a Christmas lunch and are entertained with activities and fun games in the stadium. Those kids later receive school uniforms as well as school shoes at the beginning of the school year.

I just wish well for people. I hope they reach their true potential and never give up on their dreams. It's tough in the world but people need to push through their fears and manifest what's aligned to them.
