

## Khoza must apologise publically – HRC

Simphiwe Mthembu, publicity and events manager for SABC1 has denied that he has been fired, despite the fact that his post is being advertised in the SABC's in-house publication *Intercom*, according to the *Sowetan*. SABC spokesperson Kaizer Kganyago was not able to comment on the situation.

After Talk Radio 702's host Redi Direko read Monday's *Sowetan* article on the humiliation of Nwabisi Ngcukana by taxi drivers and hawkers and then cried openly on air as she recounted her own experiences of sexual harassment, she was "inundated with phone calls and emails afterwards", writes IOL.
