- Images and text from participants will be enlarged and featured on the walls of the ADC Gallery in NY on the night of the party, 24 March.
- Submissions must be received by 22 March midnight.

The "A Young Guns Parade and Funeral March for Fighters and Lovers" event (see image attached) and I Fight For project continue the dramatic and dark "secret society" theme designed for this year's YG9 call for entries by Nessim Higson (YG5) to express the message that creatives are in a constant battle to fight for their work.
