

TopTV shelves HD plans

[TopTV](#) has no immediate plans to introduce a personal video recorder (PVR) or high-definition (HD) broadcasts, despite earlier promises by former CEO [Vino Govender](#), who recently left the pay-TV operator's employ, that it would introduce such products.

Govender had said previously that TopTV would launch an HD PVR product in 2011, but the company later pushed out the launch date to the second quarter of 2012. It insisted the products were coming because people in its target market - living standards measures 5-8 - were demanding HD broadcasts.

Now, however, chairman and acting CEO [Eddie Mbalu](#) says TopTV has shelved its plans for an HD PVR, at least for now.
