

Copper worth R17,9-million stolen in June

Times Live says copper worth R17,9-million was stolen in June, down from the R23-million in May according to the *Copper Theft Barometer* compiled by the South African Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Sacci).

The chamber says that 288 tons of copper were stolen by thieves in June compared with 356 in May, a drop of 19%. According to Sacci the lower volume and value of stolen copper indicates that thefts have dropped substantially, reports *Times Live*.
