Sky Events will be taking 22 diners up 40m in the sky at a time, for the next few months at the Fairway Hotel, Spa & Golf Resort. With a 360 degree view of the Randpark Golf Course greenery, guests will enjoy either breakfast, lunch, dinner or snacks, prepared by the executive chef and the team.



Sky Events and Chef Jean-Piere Siegenthaler's menus for the airborne guests will include treats such as baby potato and goats cheese terrine, duck leg confit, topped with forest mushrooms and cappuccino cheese cake.
